


# Impact of Online Abuse

We're documenting the real life impacts of online hate. As of August 8, 2022, 278 respondents filled out our anonymous #ToxicHush survey.


Below is the data from a few of the questions.

When survey respondents were asked if they experienced and/or noticed an increase in online harassment, abuse or hate since 2020, they answered:


● Yes ● No ● Not sure




Those who responded to the survey are on social media for one or more of the following reasons:




For those who reported experiencing online hate, they faced the abuse on:
